By submitting your entry you agree to the terms and conditions of the Dragon Trail Design Competition below.

#### **Terms and Conditions (Special Rules)**

- 1. Competition starts on March 20, 2014, and closes on April 13, 2014, at 11.59pm.
- 2. You can enter more than one design but on separate entry forms, photocopies are accepted.
- 3. Entries can be hand-drawn or created electronically on the outline provided.
- 4. Entrants must live, work or go to school in Somerset, defined by the area administered by Somerset County Council. Those who live outside but work in Somerset may be asked to prove the same.
- 5. The Gazette reserves the right to edit and modify all designs selected to appear on the Dragons.
- 6. ASSIGNMENT OF COPYRIGHT:
- 6.1 In consideration of having your design appear on a Deane Dragon, you agree to assign absolutely the entire copyright of your design to Newsquest Media (Southern) Limited publishers of the Somerset County Gazette ("Gazette").
- 6.2 Entries must be your own original work and must not include any third party copyright-protected images/logos/work of any kind.
- 6.3 You will retain moral rights in your entry arising under the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 and, so far as is legally possible and any broadly equivalent rights you may have in any territory of the world.
- 6.4 By submitting any entry you grant the Gazette a worldwide royalty-free, irrevocable and perpetual licence to use the entry in any and all media (including digital and print) for publicity and news purposes.
- 6.5 No entries will be returned.
- 6.6. Any entries received after the competition closing date will not be considered by the judges.
- 7. Judges will shortlist designs that will be put forward for use on the dragons. The judges' decision will be final.
- 8. Designs may be modified as they are transferred to the Deane Dragons.
- 9. Winning entrants will be notified if their entry is chosen to go on a Deane Dragon. Deane Dragon Sponsors can choose which entry from the shortlisted designs they would like on their sponsored Deane Dragon, in accordance with the procedure drawn up by the Trail Organisers, downloadable from www.somersetcountygazette.co.uk/dragon\_trail
- 10. The number of winning entries chosen to be used on Deane Dragons will depend on the number of Sponsors supporting the project and Trail Organisers have the right to choose a limited number of other designs for the Deane Dragons.
- 11. The Gazette will decide who transposes the entry onto the Deane Dragon but winning entrants are welcome to express an interest in completing this task if they so wish.
- 13. Misrepresentative, fraudulent or plagiarised entries or designs will invalidate an entry. The Gazette reserves the right, with or without cause, to exclude entrants from the Competition and the Gazette, may at its discretion, withhold prizes for violation of any of these terms and conditions.
- 14. Winners' names will appear on the plaque on the Deane Dragon base and on the Trail website and winners will also receive a certificate of recognition.
- 15. The Gazette reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions. Any amendments will be published on somersetcountygazette.co.uk/dragon\_trail you are advised to regularly check the website for any changes.
- 16. The Gazette reserves the right to publish any entries (in whole or in part) and publication does not necessarily mean the entrant has won.
